To be chosen at the Convocational meetings for Diocesan Council:

Alexandria — a lay woman to replace Marian Keator

Lake Charles — a lay woman to replace Harriet Green

Monroe — a lay woman to replace Lou Taylor

Shreveport — a lay woman to replace Jane Sistrunk

Voted upon by the Convention body:

Standing Committee

Standing Committee terms are for 3 years (See Canon 27: Nominated by Convocations and elected at Convention)

Acadiana — Lay woman or man to replace Rev. Annie Etheredge

Lake Charles — Cleric to replace Roxanne Myers

Disciplinary Board

1 cleric from any convocation is needed to complete the quorum of 3 clergy, 3 laity, and 1 at large person, as required by canon. However, Bishop Owensby encourages that we have more than the minimum. Therefore, any amount of laity or clergy may stand for election.

University of the South

Lay person (not gender specific) to replace Andrea Petrosh.

General Convention

There is no minimum for the number of nominations. See Canon 8: Deputies to the General Convention and to the Provincial Synod

Requirements for Clergy Deputy to General Convention:

1. Physically and canonically resident
2. Actively serving in a diocesan cure

Requirements for Lay Deputy to General Convention:

1. Must be 18 years or older
2. Confirmed communicant in good standing
